

bound in cloth and deposited in the State library for the use thereof, and that the said society be and hereby is authorized without being required to pay therefor to send a copy of each of the volumes that have been or may be published to the respective State librarians of the several States of the Union, and also to each of the Circuit Courts of the several counties of the State, to the Court of Appeals, the land office, the library company of the Baltimore bar, and such library or historical associations as may be approved by the Maryland Historical Society.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 255.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County to levy upon the taxable property of said county a sufficient sum of money for the erection of two school-houses for white children in said county, one in the first election district, and the other in the seventh election district of said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to levy upon the taxable property of said county a sufficient sum of money for the erection of two school houses for white children in said county, one of said school houses to be located in the first election district and the other in the seventh election district of said county.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That said school houses shall be directed under the supervision and control of the school commissioners for said county, and the sites for said school houses in said district shall be determined by said school commissioners.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted;* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
