CHAPTER 288.

AN ACT to sanction the bequest of John Young of C., to the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Frederick of the residue of the testator's estate, to be applied to the Evangelical Lutheran Sunday School of Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Sanction of Maryland, That the sanction and consent of the said Gen-bequest. eral Assembly be and is hereby given to the bequest of John Young of C., late of Frederick County, deceased, of the residue of the testator's estate, to the Evangelical Lutheran Church at Frederick to be applied to the Evangelical Lutheran Sunday School at Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this act shall Effective take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 290.

AN ACT to carry into effect section one of article seven of the constitution of Maryland, so far as the same relates to Carroll County, and to repeal section 18 of article seven, Code of Public Local Laws, title "Carroll County," subtitle "County Commissioners," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section eighteen of article seven, Code of Amend-Public Local Laws, title "Carroll County," sub-title "County" Commissioners," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

SEC. 18. There shall be three County Commissioners for Carroll County, and of the three commissioners elected to Terms of office on the Tuesday next after the first Monday in the commismonth of November, eighteen hundred and ninety-one, one, to wit, Hezekiah Hann, shall hold office for the space of two years; one, to wit, Joshua F. Caltvider, shall hold office for the space of four years; and one, to wit, David Stoner, shall hold office for the space of six years, and all elections hereafter to be held for County Commissioner of Carroll County, the person elected shall hold office for a term of six years.
