so that there shall be an election for one county commissioner every two years, beginning the Tuesday next after the first Monday in the month of November, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-three.

Effective. SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 291.

AN ACT to repeal section fourteen of article twenty-five of the Code of Public General Laws title "County Commissioners," so far as the same relates to Talbot County and to repeal section thirty-one of article twenty-one of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Talbot County," sub-title "County Commissioners—Compensation," and to re-enact the last named section with amendments so far as to fix the terms and compensation of the County Commissioners of Talbot County.

Repeal

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section fourteen of article twenty-five of the Code of Public General Laws, title "County Commissioners," be and the same is hereby repealed so far as the same relates to Talbot County and that section thirty-one of article twenty-one of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Talbot County," sub-title "County Commissioners—Compensation," be and the same is hereby repealed and this last named section re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

SEC. 31. There shall be three County Commissioners of Talbot County; they shall receive four dollars for each day they shall be engaged in the discharge of their duties and mileage at the rate of ten cents per mile for every mile from their places of residence to the county seat, that the present Board of County Commissioners for said county of Talbot shall hold their respective offices to which they were severally elected at the last general election for four years from the date of their said election or until their successors shall be elected and qualified, and that the county commissioners hereafter to be elected for said county shall be elected on general ticket by the qualified voters of said county on the Tuesday next after the first Monday in the month of November in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five, as follows: One
