Preamble. WHEREAS, said Talbot County at an election held on the eight day of November in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-seven determined by a majority of its qualified voters to endorse the bonds of said railroad company to the amount of fifty thousand dollars and,

Preamble. WHEREAS, the said Act of Assembly of eighteen hundred and eighty-six, chapter five hundred and nine was by joint resolution number eleven duly approved by the General Assembly of eighteen hundred and eighty-eight as the constitution of this State directs ; and,

Preamble. WHEREAS, by an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at its January session in the year eighteen hundred and ninety chapter one hundred and fifty-eight the Baltimore and Eastern Shore Railroad Company agree to except from Talbot County a subscription of twenty-five thousand dollars to the capital stock of said company in lieu of the endorsement of its second mortgage bonds to the amount of fifty thousand dollars as hereinbefore recited and the County Commissioners of Talbot County were authorized and empowered to subscribe to the capital stock of said railroad company to the amount of said sum of twenty-five thousand dollars, provided, the question of such subscription should be first submitted to the qualified voters of said county at an election then to be held on the fourth day of November, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety, and a majority of said qualified voters voting at said election should determine in favor of such subscription and,

Preamble. WHEREAS, at said election held on the fourth day of November, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety the question of subscription of twenty-five thousand dollars by Talbot County to the capital stock of said railroad company was submitted to the qualified voters of said county and a majority of the voters voting at said election did determine in its favor and it now becomes necessary for the County Commissioners of Talbot County to carry out in good faith the agreement made by them with said railroad company and ratified by a majority of the voters of said county in the manner hereinbefore recited therefore,

To issue bonds. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland.* That the County Commissioners of Talbot County be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to issue coupon bonds of said Talbot County to be signed by the president of the board of commissioners of said county
