

by said committee and certified by them to the County Commissioners under the provisions of this act, and from the decision of said committee or a majority thereof there shall be no appeal but the same shall be final and conclusive and further that in making up the amount of said claims the said committee shall not consider or include in their estimate any costs or expense which may have been incurred by any claimant in prosecuting his her or its claim against said railroad company, any vacancy occurring in said committee by death removal or otherwise shall be filled by the County Commissioners of Talbot County.

**fo levy a tax** SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners of Talbot County, be and they are hereby authorized and directed to levy annually upon the taxable property of said county a tax to be collected as other taxes of said county are collected sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds to be issued as aforesaid as it becomes due and payable.

**Exempt from taxation.** SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That the bonds hereby authorized to be issued shall be exempt from county and municipal taxation, and that the coupons due on said bonds shall be received by the collector of taxes in Talbot County in payment of county taxes.

**Effective.** SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 296.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with additions and amendments sections thirty-nine, forty, forty-one, forty-two, forty-three, forty-four, forty-five, forty-six, and forty-seven of article forty-three, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Health," sub-title "Practitioners of Medicine" and to additional sections thereto to be designated as sections, forty-nine, fifty, fifty-one and fifty two.

**Repealed and re-enacted.** SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sections thirty-nine, forty, forty-one, forty-two, forty-three, forty-four, forty-five, forty-six and forty-seven, of article forty-three, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Health," sub-title "Practitioners of Medicine" be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments and additions, and that new sections be added
