

## CHAPTER 300.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections 3 and 4 of chapter 538 of the Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Elections," as enacted by the acts of eighteen hundred and ninety.

Repeal. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections 3 and 4 of chapter 538 of the acts of 1890 be repealed, amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

Applicable to whole State SEC. 3. That this act shall apply to the whole State.

Effective SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage, and that all acts or parts of acts in consistent with this act are hereby repealed.

## CHAPTER 301.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Washington and Chesapeake Beach Railway Company.

Amendment SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the charter heretofore granted under and by virtue of the General Laws of the State of Maryland, to wit, on the first day of September eighteen hundred and ninety-one, and recorded in the office of the Secretary of State, on the eleventh day of September eighteen hundred and ninety-one be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows :

Name That the name of the said corporation shall be "The Washington and Chesapeake Railway Company," and by that name shall have perpetual succession, and shall be able to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, defend and be defended, in all courts of equity and law, and may have a common seal, and alter the same at its pleasure; and its principal place of business shall be in the city of Washington, District of Columbia, and its principal office, in the State of Maryland, shall be at Chesapeake Beach.

Officers. SEC. 2. That the officers of said company shall consist of a president, vice-president, treasurer, and secretary and a board of eleven directors; that said directors shall be chosen by the stockholders in annual meeting, which shall be held on the second Tuesday in January in each year, and the directors of said company, or a majority of them, shall have
