

## CHAPTER 318.

AN ACT to authorize the trustees of the Johns Hopkins University, a corporation incorporated under the General Laws of Maryland to make and constitute the president for the time being of its University, and each of his successors in said office during their respective terms thereof a member *ex-officio* of the board of trustees of the Johns Hopkins University, in addition to the number of twelve trustees of said university now authorized by law.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the trustees of the Johns Hopkins University, a corporation duly incorporated by certificate under the General Laws of Maryland, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make and constitute the president for the time being of the Johns Hopkins University, and each of his successors in said office, during their respective terms thereof, a member *ex-officio* of said board of trustees, in addition to the number of twelve trustees of said university now authorized by law.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 319.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Home and Infirmary of Western Maryland in the City of Cumberland by repealing section three of the act of eighteen hundred and ninety chapter one hundred and ninety and re-enact the said section with amendments providing that seven of the twelve directors of said corporation shall be appointed by the Governor.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section three of the act of eighteen hundred and ninety be and is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the Board of Directors of said corporation shall consist of twelve persons seven of whom shall be appointed by the Governor to represent the interests of the State in said institution.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
