

## CHAPTER 320.

AN ACT to refund to Henry C. Rawlings, trustee of J. H. Harrington, late collector of taxes for the second district of Caroline County, the sum of one hundred and four dollars and fifty-one cents for money paid into the State treasury of the State of Maryland in excess of the amount due by him to the State of Maryland for taxes for the years eighteen hundred and eighty-six, eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight and eighteen hundred and eighty-nine.

WHEREAS, It appears by the books of the comptroller's office that J. H. Harrington, late collector of taxes for Caroline County, has paid into the treasury of the State of Maryland the sum of one hundred and four dollars and fifty-cents in excess of the amount due by him for State taxes for the years eighteen hundred and eighty-six, eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight and eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, and

WHEREAS, the treasury officers of the State of Maryland have recommended the passage of a law refunding the said sum of money to said collector, and

WHEREAS, the said Henry C. Rawlings, has been appointed by the Circuit Court of Caroline County trustee for the benefit of creditors of the said John H. Harrington and is the proper person to receive the same, therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the treasurer of the State of Maryland be and is hereby required upon the warrant of the comptroller of the State of Maryland, to pay to Henry C. Rawlings, trustee as aforesaid, the sum of one hundred and four dollars and fifty-one cents out of any moneys in the treasury of the State of Maryland not otherwise appropriated.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
