

CHAPTER 321.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments section thirty-one of article twelve of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Garrett County," sub-title "County Commissioners," and to add two additional sections to said article to be designated thirty-one A, and thirty-one B, relating to the election and term of service of said county commissioners, and the filling of any vacancy which may occur in the same.

Amendment and new sections. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section thirty-one of article twelve of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Garrett County," sub-title "County Commissioners," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, to read as follows: and that the following new sections be added to said article to follow section thirty-one, and to be numbered section thirty-one A, and section thirty one B, and to read as follows:

Terms of County Commissioners 31. The three County Commissioners of Garrett County, elected at the general election on the Tuesday next after the first Monday in the month of November, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one, shall hold their office for two years from the time of their election, and shall receive the same compensation as now provided by law.

Terms of County Commissioners to be hereafter elected 31 A. At the general election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November, eighteen hundred and ninety-three, there shall be elected three County Commissioners for Garrett County, that is to say, two for the term of four years and one for the term of two years; and from and after such election, there shall be three County Commissioners for Garrett County, and at every general election in every second year thereafter, there shall be elected respectively on the first such general election, one commissioner to serve for the term of four years, and at the second such general election thereafter, there shall be elected two commissioners to serve for the term of four years, and the terms of all commissioners after the first election provided for in this act shall be for four years, and said commissioners so elected shall receive the same compensation as now provided by law.

Vacancy. 31 B. If at any time the number of county commissioners shall be reduced to less than three, the Governor shall appoint a proper person to fill such vacancy until the general
