

CHAPTER 324.

AN ACT to pay to the school commissioners of Garrett County a sum of money out of the State school tax.

Preamble. WHEREAS, in view of pressure of the present apportionment specially upon Garrett County of the State School Fund and her inability without larger increase of county taxation to keep open her schools for more than four or five months and in view of the fact that mountain ridges so divide the population of Garrett County, the largest county of the State in area, as to render school facilities for all the children more expensive than in the more level parts of the State.

Preamble. AND WHEREAS, it has been unanimously recommended by the State Board of Education and a committee appointed by the State Teacher's Association that such sum of money should be paid out of the State School Fund to the Board of School Commissioners for Garrett County, therefore,

Appropriation. SECTION 7. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and required to draw his warrant upon the treasurer in favor of the Garrett County School Board, for the sum of four thousand dollars per annum for two years out of the proceeds of the State school tax.

Effective SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its approval by the Governor.

CHAPTER 325.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments section one hundred and thirty-eight of chapter five hundred and thirty-eight of the acts of eighteen hundred and ninety, title "Election."

Amendment. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section one hundred and thirty-eight of the acts passed January session, eighteen hundred and ninety, title "Elections," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :
