

Powers. successors, property, real and personal not exceeding in value the sum of ten thousand dollars, and the same at its pleasure, to transfer or dispose of in such manner as it may think proper; provided always that said property shall never be divided among the members of the corporation, but shall descend to their successors, for the benevolent relief of the sick and distressed, the education of the orphans of its members, and for the promotion of those purposes generally.

Effective SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 327.

AN ACT to authorize and require the County Commissioners of Somerset County to levy for and pay to the judges of the Orphans' Court of Somerset County, the same mileage as is now allowed to the county commissioners by the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland.

Mileage for Orphan's Court Judges. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Somerset County, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to allow and levy for the judges of the Orphans' Court of Somerset County, the same mileage, in addition to the per diem, as is now allowed by law and levied for the County Commissioners of Somerset County.

Effective. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 328.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the mayor and council of Salisbury in Wicomico County, to borrow money and issue bonds for the purchase of a lot and the erection of a market-house in said city.

Erect a market house SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the mayor and council of Salisbury be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to purchase a lot and erect a market-house in said city, and for that purpose
