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CHAPTER 330.

AN ACT to repeal article one of section four of chapter one hundred and sixty-nine of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at the January session eighteen hundred and seventy-eight entitled an act to continue the corporate existence of the president, directors and company of the Hagerstown Bank and to re-enacted the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That article one of section four of chapter one hundred and sixty-nine of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session eighteen hundred and seventy-eight entitled an act to continue the corporate existence of the president, directors and company of the Hagerstown Bank, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows. Amendment

ARTICLE 1. *And be it further enacted,* That every stockholder shall be entitled to one vote for each share of stock, which he, she, or they may hold of the capital stock of said bank, but no share of stock shall entitle any holder to a vote which shall not have been holders four calendar months previous to the day of any election in said bank. Entitled to vote.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

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CHAPTER 331.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and fifty-five, of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, "Carroll County," sub-title "Taneytown," and re-enact the same so as to read as follows :
