CHAPTER 344.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money for the purpose of thoroughly repairing, repainting, frescoing and refurnishing the executive mansion.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sum of ten thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of thoroughly repairing, repainting, frescoing and refurnishing the executive mansion. Appropriation for executive mansion

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted* That His Excellency, Frank Brown, Governor of Maryland, be and he is hereby authorized to have the executive mansion thoroughly repaired, repainted, frescoed and refurnished ; and the comptroller is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer for such amounts as the Governor may require ; provided the sum or sums so required shall not exceed in the aggregate, the said sum of ten thousand dollars ; and the Governor shall make return to the comptroller of the amount expended, together with the vouchers for the same. Governor to repair mansion.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect Effective from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 345.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the mayor and city council of Baltimore to appropriate annually a sum of money to pay for the use of a suitable building to be occupied by the members of the Veteran Volunteer Firemen's Association of Baltimore City.
