Appropria and they are hereby authorized and empowered to appro-Baltimore priate annually the sum of one thousand dollars, to pay for city for the use of a suitable building to be occupied by the members of the Veteran Volunteer Firemen's Association of Baltimore City.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Effective. from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 346.

AN ACT to repeal certain sections of article twenty of the Code of Public Local Laws, being the Local Code for Somerset County sub-title "County Commissioners" and sub-title "Revenue and Taxes" and to enact other sections in lieu thereof respecting the term of office and power of the County Commissioners.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections forty-one, forty-two, forty-three, Repealed forty-eight, two hundred and seventeen and two hundred re-enacted and eighteen of article twenty of the Public Local Laws, being the local laws for Somerset County be and the same are hereby repealed and the following sections and provisions are enacted in their stead to read as follows:

SEC. 41. The county is hereby divided into three com-Somerset missioner districts as follows: Princess Anne No. 1, Fair-County— mount No. 6, and Dublin No. 4, shall constitute commissioner district No. 1; Mount Vernon district No. 5, Saint Peters No. 2, Dame Quarter No. 11, and Langer district No. 9, shall constitute commissioner district No. 2; and the remaining districts of the county shall constitute commissioner district No. 3; and the Board of County Commissioners shall consist of the persons one from each of these commissioner districts; and the term of office of all hereafter to be elected shall be six years, and in order to bring about the election of one commissioner every two years, and no more, that is to say one at every general election the term for which the members of the present board shall respectively serve shall be two, four, and six years respectively, from the last election and until their successors are elected and qualified, and which of the board shall have these several terms shall be determined by lot cast or drawn in the presence of and by the direction of one of the judges of the Circuit Court for Somerset County at one of the
