

cause to be affixed thereto the respective sums to be collected from each person, and a warrant to the bailiff to collect the same.

**Enforce the payment of taxes.** SEC. 16. *Be it enacted,* That the bailiff appointed by the commissioners may enforce the payment of corporation taxes in the same manner and with like effect as collectors of State and county taxes may enforce the payment of State and county taxes.

**Bailiff to make collections.** SEC. 17. *Be it enacted,* That the bailiff shall make all collections required of him and pay the same to the clerk in six months from the time the tax list is placed in his hands, and which said clerk shall hold together with all the moneys received by him subject to the order of the commissioners.

**Duties of bailiff.** SEC. 18. *Be it enacted,* That the bailiff shall attend the meetings of the commissioners and perform such duties as it may direct; he shall prevent disorderly or irregular meetings of persons, and he shall enforce all ordinances that may be enacted by the commissioners.

**Fees of bailiff.** SEC. 19. *Be it enacted,* That the bailiff shall have the same fees for making distresses or levying execution for taxes as are allowed county collectors; and for making arrests or serving process for violation of any ordinance of the corporation, the same fees as are allowed constables for similar service; and when the bailiff willfully fails to discharge any duty of his office, he may, in addition to the remedy on his bond, be fined by the commissioners in their discretion not exceeding ten dollars for any one offence for the payment of which said fine his bond shall be responsible.

**Expend- ing money.** SEC. 20. *Be it enacted,* That the commissioners shall not expend nor contract to expend in any one year more money than the amount receivable from taxes and other sources for that year.

**County officers.** SEC. 21. *And be it enacted,* That the commissioners for the county, justices of the peace, sheriffs, constables, and all State and county officers, shall have, hold and exercise their offices and jurisdiction in said town as if this charter had not been granted.

**Give bond** SEC. 22. *And be it enacted,* That the clerk and chief bailiff shall give bond to the commissioners in such penalties and with such sureties as said commissioners may require, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of their respective offices.

**Streets.** SEC. 23. *And be it enacted,* That the parts of the several county roads, the streets running from the Woodsborough and
