

Misdemeanor. any manner not authorized by such person, union or association, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, on conviction be punished by imprisonment in the city or county jail not less than one month nor more than one year, or by a fine of not less than fifty dollars or more than two hundred dollars, or both in the discretion of the court.

Misdemeanor. SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That any person or persons who shall in any way use the name or seal of any such person, association or union, or officer thereof, in and about the sale of goods or otherwise, not being authorized to so use the same, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable on conviction by imprisonment in the city or county jail for a term of not less than three months or more than one year, or by a fine of not less fifty dollars nor more than three hundred dollars, or both in the discretion of the court.

Repeal. SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That all the acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

Effective. SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 358.

AN ACT to add a further supplement to the act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at December session eighteen hundred and forty, chapter two hundred and fifteen, entitled "An act for cleaning out the Pocomoke River by Means of a Lottery" and the supplement thereto, namely; Act passed at the session eighteen hundred and forty-five, chapter three hundred and twenty-one, act passed at session of eighteen hundred and forty-six, chapter three hundred and sixty-one, act passed at session of eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, chapter one hundred and seventy-eight, act passed at session of eighteen hundred and sixty, chapter one hundred and ninety-six, act passed at session of eighteen hundred and sixty-two, chapter one hundred and ten, act passed at session of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter eighty-four, act passed at session of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter four hundred and thirty-six, providing for the appointment of new commissioners, and defining their powers and duties.
