

shall, after deducting five per centum commissions and costs of suit, immediately pay over the balance to the commissioners created by this act, or their lawful agent.

Filling vacancies. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That if any of the commissioners herein named, shall die, resign or refuse to act, or remove from Worcester County, the remaining commissioners shall appoint a commissioner in his place, so as to keep up the number of five commissioners, and the said commissioners so appointed, or their successors, shall have and exercise all the powers conferred by this act and that now exist, under the supplements referred to in the title of this act.

Effective. SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 359.

AN ACT to enlarge and define the taxable limits of Frederick City, to establish certain avenues, streets at the Boulevard as at present located, to fix the grade and macadamize the same, to provide water facilities in the northwestern addition to Frederick, and to repeal section two hundred and fifty-four of article eleven of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Frederick County" sub-title "Frederick" and to enact a substitute in lieu thereof.

Amendments. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section two hundred and fifty-four of article eleven of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Frederick County," sub-title "Frederick," be and the same is hereby repealed, and that the following be and is hereby enacted in lieu thereof as a substitute therefor.

Taxable limits of Frederick 254. The taxable limits of Frederick shall be as follows: Beginning in the middle of the Frederick and Woodsboro turnpike roads at the end of twenty-eight and four-tenths perches north of the north line of Eighth street, and at the end of one and seventy-two one-hundredths perches on a line drawn south eighty-one degrees east from the south-east corner of Thomas W. Morgan's lot, and running thence parallel with Eighth street south eighty-one degrees east ninety-seven and fifty-two one-hundredths perches to a stake planted eighteen perches east of the eastern limits of the
