shall be final and conclusive in any such case, and the registration shall at once be made to conform to the order of said court unless reversed by the Court of Appeals provided in section twenty-one.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Effective. from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 369.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments section six hundred and fifty-three D, article four of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Liquor and Intoxicating Drinks," as said section appears in chapter three hundred and forty-three of the acts of 1890.

SECTION. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section six hundred and fifty-three D of Amendarticle four of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Liquor and Intoxicating Drinks," as said section appears in chapter three hundred and fortythree of the acts of eighteen hundred and ninety, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

653 D. The said board shall fix the salaries of all clerks appointed by them for the performance of the duties imposed Salaries. by this act, and the members of said board shall each receive a salary of two thousand dollars annually to be paid as the salaries of officers of the city of Baltimore are paid.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Effective from the date of its passage.
