

**Amend-** Local Laws, title "Montgomery County," sub-title "Birds  
**ment.** and Game," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-  
enacted so as to read as follows :

**Limit of** 55. No person shall trap, shoot or in any manner catch,  
**time for** kill or take, any partridge in Montgomery County between  
**killng** the fifteenth day of December and the first day of November ;  
**partridges,** nor any woodcock between the first day of January and the  
**&c** first day of July ; nor any pheasant between the first day of  
January and the first day of September ; nor any woodcock  
between the first day of January and the first day of Sep-  
tember ; nor any wild turkey between the first day of Feb-  
ruary and the first day of November ; nor any rabbit between  
the first day of February and the first day of September ; nor  
any gray squirrel between the fifteenth day of December and  
the first day of August.

**Effective.** SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect  
from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 371.

AN ACT to refund to William S. Gordy late collector of  
taxes for Wicomico County, a certain sum of money erro-  
neously paid by him into the treasury.

**Appro-** SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of*  
**riation.** *Maryland,* That the comptroller of the treasurer be and he  
is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon  
the treasurer in favor of William S. Gordy late collector of  
taxes for the fourth election district of Wicomico County, in  
the sum of fifty-two dollars and eighty-five cents said  
amount being overpaid by him into the treasury for the  
year 1885, the treasury officials having recommended the  
refunding thereof.
