be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to appropriate annually toward the current expenses or for the ben-Powerto efit of the Simmin's Home for friendless children of Balti-ate money. more any sum of money they may deem proper provided, the said sum shall not exceed one thousand and five hundred dollars.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Effective from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 373.

AN ACT to authorize the governor to appoint four additional notaries public for Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the governor, by and with the advice and Notaries consent of the Senate, is hereby authorized to appoint four public notaries public in addition to those now appointed.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Effective. from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 374.

AN ACT to prohibit the granting of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors in school district No. 5. of election district No. 9 of Worcester County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That after the first day of May in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-two, it shall not be lawful for to the clerk of the Circuit Court of Worcester County to issue licenses. a license to any person or persons to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer in school district No. 5 of election district No. 9 of said county.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Reflective. from the date of its passage.
