

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of said commissioners to thoroughly investigate the matter of the distribution of the State School Tax under existing laws, and ascertain its practical operation and effect in the various counties and the city of Baltimore, and how far the same works inequality, hardship and injustice, and the cause or causes thereof and the proper remedy. Duties.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That said commissioners shall within thirty days after their appointment, organize by electing one of their number chairman and they shall have access to the records in the State comptroller's office and the tax department of the State and counties thereof and the city of Baltimore, and all public officers shall give them all needed information. Powers.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That said commissioners shall present to the next General Assembly a full detailed and accurate report of all the matter and facts which they are by this act required to inquire into, ascertain and consider, together with their recommendations as to what legislation is necessary for the correction of the inequalities complained of. Report.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the sum of five hundred dollars or as much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated, to pay the expenses of said commission including clerical assistance. Appropriation to pay expenses.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

CHAPTER 399.

AN ACT providing that no corporation shall be dissolved by decree of any court of this State until all taxes due the State shall be fully paid or adjusted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That no corporation, made taxable by any law of this State, shall hereafter be dissolved under the decree of any court of this State until all taxes due the State have been fully paid or adjusted and the certificate of the Comptroller of the Treasury to this effect filed in the proper court with the proceedings of dissolution. State taxes.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.
