Baltimore City, which are inconsistent with the provision of this act be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 402.

AN ACT to authorize the employment of an assistant engineer on the steamers of the State Fishery Force.

WHEREAS, by an error in the engrossment of the general Preamble, oyster law passed at the present session of this General Assembly the position of assistant engineer was inadvertently left out, therefore to correct said error:

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Assistant Maryland, That the deputy commanders of steamers of the engineers. Maryland State Fishery Force be each authorized to employ one assistant engineer at a salary of five hundred dollars per annum.

SEC. 2. Be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from Effective. the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 403.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections. one hundred and twenty-five and one hundred and twentysix of article two of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "County Commissioners."

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section one hundred and twenty-five and one hundred and twenty-six of article two of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "County Commissioners," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read. as follows:
