

ernor shall state in the commission to be issued to said county commissioners elected at the said election to be held on the Tuesday next after the first Monday in November in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-three, the term for which the said commissioners shall respectively serve. If, of the five persons having the highest number of votes, two or more shall be residents of the same collection district, the person in said district having the highest number of votes shall be declared elected, and the persons in the respective districts having the highest number of votes shall constitute the board of county commissioners.

64. The clerk of said county commissioners shall receive such compensation and such allowances for office expenses as said county commissioners shall from time to time determine, and his duties shall be as follows :

Compensation of clerk.

A. He shall perform all the duties now by law required to be performed by said clerk, or which may be required of him by any future law or by any order of the county commissioners.

Duties.

B. He shall have charge of all records, books, and so forth, belonging to the office of the county commissioners, and shall not allow any of them to be removed or taken from said office, except in obedience to a summons or order of a court of law or equity of this State, and shall deliver the same to his successor,

Have charge of records, &c.

C. He shall receive and deliver, either in person or through the collectors of taxes, all money levied and collected for county purposes, according to the order of the county commissioners of said county.

Receive money.

D. He shall monthly, immediately after his monthly settlements with the several collectors of taxes of said county, as provided for in section 219 of this article, pay over to the Comptroller of the Treasurer of Maryland, all money levied and collected for said State in said county.

Pay to Comptroller.

E. He shall keep a separate account of both State and county levies with each collector of taxes in said county, and shall make out and preserve a duplicate of each and every receipt given by him for all public money received by him, and shall state in said receipts what amount of the public dues is received in cash, and what amount in county orders ; and the sums received by him on account of the county levy shall be disbursed exclusively for county purposes, and any person for whose use a levy is made shall be entitled to receive the same in full on the first day of January next succeeding the date of such levy provided how-
