tion. laws that shall have occurred before the passage of this act, shall be prosecuted to conviction and punishment to the same extent as if this act had not been passed.

Effective. SEC. 22. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 425.

AN ACT to repeal sections three, four, five, six, seven, eight, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen, twenty-one, twenty-two, twenty-three, twenty-four, twenty-six, twenty-seven, twenty-eight, twenty-nine, thirty, thirty-one, thirty-two, thirty-three, thirty-four, thirty-five, and thirty-six of chapter one hundred and thirty-two of the acts passed at the January, eighteen hundred and ninety, session of the General Assembly of Maryland, and to re-enact the same with amendments, so as to read as follows :

Amend-  
ment. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sections three, four, five, six, seven, eight, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen, twenty-one, twenty-two, twenty-three, twenty-four, twenty-six, twenty-seven, twenty-eight, twenty-nine, thirty, thirty-one, thirty-two, thirty-three, thirty-four, thirty-five, and thirty-six of chapter one hundred and thirty-two of the acts passed at the January, eighteen hundred and ninety, session of the General Assembly of Maryland, be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows :

Mayor SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the male citizens of the age of twenty-one years and upwards, who have resided within the corporate limits of Lonaconing six months next preceding the election, and who shall have been registered as hereinafter prescribed, shall on the first Tuesday of — in each and every year, at such place as the mayor and councilmen may designate, within the corporate limits of said town, elect one person residing within said town mayor of the town of Lonaconing.

men. SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the persons qualified as required by the preceding section, shall annually elect three persons who shall have resided in said town six months
