B., No. 1102, folio 244, &c.; sixth, a deed from James Young, dated the 3rd day of January, 1887, and recorded as aforesaid in Liber J. B., No. 1124, folio 187, &c., and seventh, a deed from James Young, dated the 13th day of April, 1887, and recorded as aforesaid in Liber J. B., No. 1136, folio 314, &c.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland are hereby given, granted and declared to the acquisition by the several religious denominations or sects, orders or corporations above named, at any time hereafter, whether by gift, grant, devise or otherwise, of the fee simple title to the lots or parcels of land above mentioned, in which they are respectively entitled to a leasehold interest, or less than a fee simple title, by virtue of the several deeds and devises above mentioned, and by virtue of the sanction heretofore given by the first section of this act.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 431.

AN ACT to repeal section two hundred and seventy-seven of article ten of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Roads," and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to add an additional section thereto, to come in after section two hundred and seventy-seven, and to be designated two hundred and seventy-seven A.
