land. A. Every person applying for a license to keep an oyster house, cook shop, victualling house, tavern, lager beer saloon, or ordinary to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer within three miles of the corporate limits of the city of Cumberland, in every direction, but not within said city, shall file with the clerk of the Circuit Court for Allegany County, his or her petition for such license, and shall at the same time pay to said clerk two dollars for expenses therewith, and said clerk shall cause to be published three times in two leading newspapers of Cumberland of opposite political parties, a list containing the names of all such applicants, their respective residences and the place of business for which such application is made; the first publication shall not be less than ten days, nor more than twenty days, before the time fixed by said clerk for the consideration of such application.

shall state. B. Said petition shall state the name and residence of the applicant or applicants, and how long he, she or they have resided there; second, the particular place for which a license is desired, designating the same by such apt description as definitely locates it; third, the name of the owner of the premises upon which the business licensed, is to be carried on; fourth, a statement that the applicant is a citizen of the United States; fifth, that the applicant nor applicants have not nor has either of them had a license for the sale of intoxicating liquors revoked, nor has either of them been convicted of any infamous crime within two years preceding the filing of said petition; sixth, that he, she or they will not knowingly sell or allow to be sold in said house or on said premises any liquors on Sundays or on election days or to minors, at any time, or allow a minor to drink in said house or on said premises; seventh, that he, she or they will not permit gambling or keep or permit to be kept a bawdy house in said house or on said premises, or the gathering together in said house or on said premises of women for lewd or immoral purposes; eighth, the names of not less than two reputable freeholders of Allegany County who will be his, her or their sureties on the bond which is required by this act and a statement that each of said sureties is a *bona fide* owner of real estate in said county worth over and above all incumbrances the sum of five hundred dollars. This statement shall be verified by the affidavit, of the applicant or applicants, made before a justice of the peace. If any false statement be made in
