each and every violation, when the amount of the insurance is twenty-five thousand dollars or less; and for every additional twenty-five thousand dollars of insurance or less, there shall be an additional penalty of five hundred dollars and such offender or offenders shall be prohibited from doing insurance business in the State of Maryland until said fine is paid, or the said fine or penalty may be sued for and recovered in the name of the State of Maryland by the State's attorney of the county or city in which such agent or agents may reside or in which the offence is committed, onehalf of said penalty, when recovered, shall be paid into the treasury of the State, the other half to the informer of such violation.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Effective. from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 442.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments section one hundred and twelve of article two of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," subtitle "County Commissioners," and to add two new sections thereto to follow immediately after section one hundred and twelve and to be designated as sections one hundred and twelve A and one hundred and twelve B.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section one hundred and twelve of article two of Amendthe Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "County Commissioners," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments and that two new sections be and the same are hereby added to said article two to follow immediately after section one hundred and twelve to be designated as sections one hundred and twelve A, and one hundred and twelve B and to read as to said respective sections as follows:

112. After the expiration of the terms of office of the five County Commissioners for Anne Arundel County, who were elected on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of Number of County November eighteen hundred and ninety-one, the expiration commissioners of whose terms of office is hereinafter provided for, there shall be elected at the general election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November eighteen hundred and ninety-three, three County Commissioners for
