

be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to issue bonds of said council of Brunswick to be designated as **improvement bonds**, not exceeding the sum of twenty thousand dollars, in the aggregate in sums of not less than fifty dollars each, in four series, to be signed by the mayor of said town and countersigned by the clerk thereof and sealed with the corporate seal; said bonds to bear interest payable semi-annually on the first day of June, and on the first day of December in each and every year, at a rate of interest not exceeding the sum of six per centum, per annum, for which interest proper coupons shall be attached to said bonds, signed and countersigned as aforesaid.

When payable. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That said bonds shall be issued, payable twenty-five years from the date thereof; and redeemable at any time after the expiration of ten years from the date, at the pleasure of said council of Brunswick; and shall be exempt from all county and municipal taxation.

Payment of interest. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the council of Brunswick shall provide annually out of the annual tax levy an annual amount sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds and they shall set apart the further sum of two hundred dollars for each series issued to be invested in such securities as they may select to create a sinking fund for the redemption of said bonds, upon their maturity.

Dependent on vote of people. SEC. 4. Provided that the question of issuing these bonds be submitted to the people of Brunswick at the next election for mayor and common council, to be held in August, 1892, and that no contracts under this act be entered into until the issuing of said bonds shall be ratified by the people.

Effective SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 447.

AN ACT to add additional sections to article fifty-six of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Licenses," subtitle "Penalties," to be designated as sections eighty-nine B, and eighty-nine C, relating to obtaining liquors by minors and giving liquors to minors.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That two additional sections be, and they are
