

CHAPTER 486.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments section two of chapter 332 of the acts of the General Assembly of eighteen hundred and ninety, entitled "An act to regulate the measurement of peas, beans and other farm products."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section two of chapter 332 of the acts of the General Assembly of eighteen hundred and ninety, entitled "An act to regulate the measurement of peas, beans and other farm products," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows: Repealed and re-enacted.

2. That the dimensions of any barrel so used, shall be stamped by the inspector of weights, and any measures of the city of Baltimore upon the same, in three conspicuous places; and any person using a barrel for the measurement of peas, beans and like farm products, without being so stamped, shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars or more than five hundred dollars; said fine to be collected as other fines are now collected; and it shall be the duty of said inspector of weights and any measure of the city of Baltimore, from time to time to inspect the barrels used for the measurement of said peas, beans and other farm products, and to see that the provisions of this act are complied with; and upon the conviction of any person or corporation under the provisions of this act, one-half of the fine imposed shall be paid to said inspector of weights, and any measures of the city of Baltimore. Measurement of peas, beans, &c.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.
