High street to Pine street, thence with Pine street to Washington street, thence with Pine street extended in Second a straight line to the southern limit or line of said town, thence with the said southern line to the western boundary of the town, thence with the next line of said town to Horn's Point road, thence with said road to the second boundary of said town, and thence with a straight line from said second boundary to the corner of said Crowell's land at Hambrook's road, and thence with Hambrook's road and Glasgow street to the beginning.

Third ward, beginning for the third ward at the foot of Gay street, thence with Court lane to High street; thence with High to Pine street, thence with Pine to Muir street, thence with Muir street to the creek, thence running down and binding with the creek to the place of beginning.

Third

Fourth ward, beginning for the fourth ward at the foot of Muir street, thence with Muir to Pine street, thence with Pine to the southern limit of the town, thence running and binding with the southern and eastern limits of said town to the creek, thence running and binding with the creek to the place of beginning.

Fourth

Fifth ward, all that part of said town located in East Cambridge shall constitute the fifth ward.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Reflectives from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 488.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and twenty-eight, of article twenty-three, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, entitled "Corporations," sub-title "Insurance Department" and to enact the same with amendments.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section one hundred and twenty eight, of Repealed article twenty three, of the Code of Public General Laws, and re-enacted. of Maryland entitled "Corporations" sub-title "Insurance Department," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:
