for the sum of (\$1,175) eleven hundred and seventy-five dollars, being the amount due them for printing the State To approschool report for the year eighteen hundred and ninety.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, that this act shall Effective. take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 7.

AN ACT giving the leave and sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the acquisition of the leasehold interest in a lot of ground in the City of Baltimore by the Trustees of the Washington Street Station of the Methodist Protestant Church in the City of Baltimore and State of Maryland, a body corporate of the State of Maryland.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the leave and sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland be, and is hereby given to the acquisition by the Trustees of the Washington Street Station of the Methodist Protestant Church in the City of Baltimore and Interest State of Maryland, a body corporate of the State of Maryland, of the leasehold interest in a certain lot of ground in the City of Baltimore on the west side of Washington Street, which by deed of assignment, dated the fifth day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one, and duly recorded among the land records of Baltimore City in Liber G. R., No. 543, tolio 254, &c., was granted and assigned by William Anderson to said corporation, subject to an annual ground rent of thirty-eight dollars and seventy-five cents.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Effective. from the date of its passage.
