CHAPTER 52.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County to grant a pension to John T. Jones of the second election district of said county.

Pension. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to grant an annual pension of not less than fifty
