

## CHAPTER 503.

## AN ACT to incorporate the Robeson Cemetery Association of Garrett County.

SECTION. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Hiram Robeson, Andrew J. Lancaster and John F. Robeson and their associates and successors in office, be and they are hereby created a body politic and corporate by the name and style of the Robeson Cemetery Association, and by that name shall have perpetual succession, and shall be able and liable to sue and be sued in any court of law or equity, may have and use a common seal, and shall have power to purchase and hold not exceeding ten (10) acres of land, with authority to said corporation to receive gifts and bequests for the purpose of ornamenting and improving said cemetery, and to hold such personal property as may be requisite to carry out the objects of this act.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the affairs of said corporation shall be conducted by a board of directors, to consist of not less than three nor more than seven persons; the directors shall be elected by a majority of the vote of the proprietors; the term of service of said directors shall continue one year, or until another election; the first election under the provisions of this act shall be held on the first Tuesday of June, eighteen hundred and ninety-two, or as soon thereafter as convenient; the directors thereafter shall be elected annually, at such time and place, and in such manner as the by-laws of this corporation may direct; the directors for the time being, or a majority of them shall have the power to elect a president, secretary and treasurer from their own body, to fill vacancies that may occur, to require the secretary and treasurer to give bond as in their judgment may seem sufficient.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That said board of directors shall have power to lay out, sell or dispose of burial lots, to contract for and purchase way or ways to and from said cemetery.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That all persons may become members of this corporation or association, upon such terms as may be prescribed by the by-laws of said corporation or association.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
