

County treasurer. teen hundred and ninety-three and on the same day and month in every second year thereafter elect a suitable person of good repute and fit business capacity to be county treasurer for said county, who shall execute the required bond or bonds and qualify in the manner hereinafter provided, and shall hold his office for two years or until his successor shall be elected and qualified, commencing on the third Tuesday of the April following such election.

Collector of State and county taxes. 42 B. And the said county treasurer shall be collector of all State and county taxes for whatever purpose levied or to be levied for within said county during his term of office, or that may be placed in his hands for collection, and he shall have full power, and it shall be his bounden duty to receive and collect all State and county taxes levied as aforesaid and so placed in his hands for collection, and all moneys which may be due said county with full power to enforce the payment of the same by sale or otherwise as hereinafter prescribed and to convey to any purchaser by a good and sufficient deed any real or personal property sold by him for the payment of any State or county taxes or both in the manner provided in the succeeding section of this article.

Subject to removal. 42 C. The said treasurer shall be subject to removal from office at all times by the judges of the Circuit Court for Garrett County upon conviction for willful neglect of duty or misdemeanor or misbehavior in office.

Effective SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 521.

AN ACT to repeal section thirty, of article twenty-six, of the Code of Public General Laws of this State, sub-title "Court of Appeals," respecting disqualification of judges and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealed and re-enacted. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section thirty of article twenty-six, of the Code of Public General Laws, sub-title "Court of Appeals," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :
