after the time so appointed as is provided in the first section of said chapter thirty-five of the acts of eighteen hundred and one.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That at all meetings of How to the said Baltimore Equitable Society, the members may vote in person or by proxy.

SEC. 3. And be it further enacted, That this act shall Effective. take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 530.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Talbot County to build a road from the town of Oxford to Vancouver's Island in said county.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Talbot County, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, in their of the Vandiscretion, to build a road, or drive-way, from the town of Couver's Oxford to Vancouver's Island in said county.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Effective-from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 531.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 410 of article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws. title, "City of Baltimore," sub-title, "House of Refuge and Reformation."

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section 410 of article 4 of the Code of Repealed Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title, re-enacted. "House of Refuge and Reformation," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

410. The mayor and city council of Baltimore are authorized and empowered to appropriate annually toward the council of current expenses of the House of Refuge and St. Mary's Baltimore to appro Industrial School, any sum or sums of money not exceed.
