

ment Funds," or "Against the Drainage and Street Improvement Funds," respectively, as such voters shall desire to vote in favor of, or against said loans; and if a majority of the votes so cast shall be "For the Drainage and Street Improvement Funds," then section two hundred and one, two hundred and two, two hundred and three, two hundred and four, two hundred and five of this act shall be in effect, and if a majority of the votes so cast shall be "Against the Drainage and Street Improvement Funds," the said sections as herein changed and amended, shall be null and void; and the mayor shall give ten days notice of the day of said election by publication in at least two newspapers of said town, for ten days before the day of said election; and it is herein further provided, that if a majority of the votes cast in said election shall be "For the Drainage and Street Improvement Funds," and any irregularity or irregularities shall occur in the manner of conducting and holding said election, such irregularity or irregularities shall not invalidate said election unless it shall clearly appear that without such irregularity or irregularities, the result of said election would have been different.

SEC. 205. The mayor and council shall cause to be kept a careful register of the bonds so issued, and the transfer thereof, and as the same are called in and paid off, they shall be canceled, and a record of the cancellation by numbers, amounts, and names of the last holders of said bonds shall be made and entered upon the books in which said bonds are registered.

CHAPTER 55.

AN ACT to repeal sections one hundred and sixty-one and one hundred and sixty-two of article twenty-two of the Code of Public Local Laws entitled "Washington County, sub-title "Hagerstown," and to re-enact the following in lieu thereof, in amending and revising the charter of Hagerstown and in providing for the government thereof, and to add new and additional sections to article twenty-two of the Code of Public Local Laws title "Washington County," sub-title Hagerstown.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland.* That section one hundred and sixty-one of article
