shall do anything at about or in relation to the conduct, or Primary elections. affecting the conduct of any primary election, which is now or may hereafter be punishable as a crime when done at about or in relation to, or affecting the conduct of any election regulated by law, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, the punishment whereof shall be that prescribed by law in the case of such elections regulated by law.

CHAPTER 549.

AN ACT to authorize the Board of Police Commissioners of Baltimore City to employ an additional clerical officer to be known as the assistant to the secretary of the board.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Board of Police Commissioners of Baltimore City, be and they are hereby authorized to employ Assistant an additional officer to be known as assistant to the secretary secretary. to the board, and that the salary of the said assistant secretary shall be twelve hundred dollars, per annum payable monthly.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Reflective. from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 550.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money for the support of the Home for Mothers and Infants of Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sum of five hundred dollars a year, for Appropriaeach of the years eighteen hundred and ninety two and eighteen hundred and ninety-three, be and the same is hereby appropriated to the Home for Mothers and Infants of Baltimore City for the support of said home; and that the treasurer of the State be and he is hereby directed on warrant of the comptroller to pay to the treasurer of said home the sum of five hundred dollars for each of the years aforesaid.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect reflective from the date of its passage.
