CHAPTER 552.

AN ACT authorizing and directing the attorney general to furnish certain information in regard to the property purchased by the Province of Maryland in seventeen hundred and fifty-five and known as Fort Frederick.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of

CHAPTER 553.

AN ACT to fix, limit and determine, the term of office of the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County, elected on Tuesday next after the first Monday in November eighteen hundred and ninety-one, in pursuance of section one of article seven, of the constitution of the State, and of such commissioners as shall be elected or appointed hereafter.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County, elected at the general election held on the Tuesday next after the first Monday in November, eighteen hundred and ninety-one, pursuant to section one of article seven of the constitution of the State, now living and the commissioner appointed by the Governor to fill the vacancy occasioned by the resignation of the remaining one so elected as aforesaid, shall hold office as follows: One of them for two years from the date of said election and until his successor shall have been elected and qualified, one of them for four years from the date of said election and until his successor shall have been elected and qualified and the remaining one for six years from the date of said election and until his successor shall have been elected and qualified, and that said three commissioners shall be designated and assigned to said several terms by lot to be determined by a drawing to be arranged and conducted by and in the presence of the clerk of the Circuit Court for said county
