SEC. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed. Repeal.

CHAPTER 562.

AN ACT authorizing the County Commissioners of Worcester and Wicomico Counties to have the Pocomoke River surveyed, and to levy a sum of money to defray the expenses thereof,

WHEREAS, the upper part of the channel of the Pocomoke River has become obstructed by logs, trees and other obstructions whereby the natural flow of the water is impeded and causes the overflow of water on the low lands adjacent to said river and doing much damage, and it being advisable to remove such obstructions, therefor Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Worcester and Wicomico Counties, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to employ a competent surveyor to survey and report on the condition of the channel of the upper part of the Pocomoke River above the town of Snow Hill to the Delaware line, as to the feasibility and expense of cleaning out the channel thereof, and for the expense of such survey, the county commissioners of each county are hereby authorized and empowered to levy the sum of one hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary to defray the expenses of such survey.
