any time imposed by the authority of this State, so long as the said lands and territories shall remain the property of the United States, and be used for the purposes aforesaid.

SEC. 3. And be it further enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 569.

AN ACT to repeal section 49 of article 9 of the code of "Public Local Laws" title Charles. County, sub-title "County Commissioners and County Treasurer" and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to add two additional sections thereto to be known as section 49 A and section 49 B.

Repealed and re-enacted. That section 49 of article 9 of the code of "Public Local Laws" title Charles County, sub-title "County Commissioners and County Treasurer" be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted as follows:

County Commissioners of Charles County SEC. 49. There shall be five county commissioners for Charles County until Tuesday after the first Monday in November eighteen hundred and ninety-three, after which time the number shall be reduced to three.

49 A. That three of the county commissioners elected on Terms of the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November eighteen hundred and ninety-one, to wit: Samuel Hawkins, Washington Hicks and John W. Golden shall hold their office for the term of two years from the date of their election that one of the county commissioners elected at said election, to wit: William F. Simms shall hold his office for the term of four years and that one of said county commissioners elected at said election, to wit: Constantine A. Bowling shall hold his office for the term of six years, and all of the said commissioners shall hold their said offices until their successors are duly elected and qualified; on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-three and every second year thereafter there shall be elected by the qualified voters of Charles County one commissioner for the term of six years.

Commissioner districts 49 B. And the county shall be divided into three commissioner districts; the first to be composed of election districts number one, four and five; the second to be composed of
