

every year ; and provided further that nothing herein contained shall be construed to prevent the owner of any blind properly licensed from extending the privilege to any person to shoot from said blind on the days the owners thereof are allowed to shoot from the same.

Blinds and decoys 255. It shall not be lawful for any person to establish a blind after said blind has been licensed, at a point in said rivers nearer to said blind than three hundred yards ; and it shall not be lawful for any person to put out decoy ducks within three hundred yards of any blind and shoot over the same from the natural shores of said river.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 583.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County to levy upon the taxable property of said county a sufficient sum of money for the erection of a school house for white children, in the fourth election district of said county.

School house. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the county commissioners of St. Mary's County, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to levy upon the taxable property of said county a sufficient sum of money, for the erection of a school house, for white children in the fourth election district of said county.

By whom to be built. SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That said school house be erected under the supervision and control of the school commissioners of said county ; and the site for said school house in said district shall be determined by said school commissioners.

Effective SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
