

subsisting creditor or creditors of such husband ; provided ^{Proviso.} that this act shall not apply to any action, suit or cause at law or in equity now pending, nor to any that may be instituted on or before the first day of January eighteen hundred and ninety-three in reference to any such sale, conveyance assignment, mortgage, lease or delivery made on or prior to the passage of this act.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect ^{Effective.} from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 587.

AN ACT to repeal section three hundred and twelve of of article ninety-three of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Testamentary Law," sub-title "Wills."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section three hundred and twelve of article ^{Repeal.} ninety-three of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Testamentary Law," sub-title "Wills," be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect ^{Effective.} from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 588.

AN ACT for the better protection of game in St. Mary's County and to prevent the shooting or taking of same by non-residents without license.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall not be lawful for any person in St. ^{Limits for} Mary's County to shoot kill or catch or in any manner to ^{killing} entrap or ensnare any partridge or quail in said county ^{game.} between the twenty-fourth day of December and the first day of November nor any woodcock between the twenty-fourth day of February and the fourth day of July, nor any rabbit between the fifteenth day January and the first day of September of each year.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That any person violating the preceding section shall be deemed guilty of a
