26. To the Visitors of the Asylum and Training School for Feeble Minded of the State of Maryland, the sum of six thousand dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-three, and the like sum of six thousand dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-four. Same.

27. To the Faculty of Physic of the University of Maryland for the use of the Baltimore Infirmary, the sum of thirty-seven hundred and fifty dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-three, and the like sum of thirty-seven hundred and fifty dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-four; provided that the said Baltimore Infirmary shall furnish one bed, maintenance and treatment for one patient at a time for each senatorial district of the State during two years from the date of the passage of this act; provided that the said hospital shall furnish to the comptroller satisfactory evidence that it has so received, maintained and treated all patients free of charge, sent to them under the provisions of this act, in consideration of the sum of money hereby appropriated and payable. Same.

28. To the Home of the Friendless in the diocese of Easton, at Easton, Maryland, the sum of five hundred dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-three, and the like sum of five hundred dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-four. Same.

29. To St. Agnes' Hospital, the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-three, and the like sum of twenty-five hundred dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-four. Same.

30. To the Baltimore Day Nursery, the sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-three, and the like sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-four. Same.
