PUBLIC DEBT.

Public debt. For the payment of the interest on the public debt of the State, three hundred and fifty thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary.

Disburse on warrant of Comptroller. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Treasurer of the State on the warrant of the Comptroller, disburse the said sum or sums of money herein appropriated for the objects and purposes herein specified, to or upon the order of the person or persons, or body politic, or corporate, entitled to receive the same.

Effective. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the first day of October, eighteen hundred and ninety-three.

CHAPTER 609.

AN ACT to add an additional section to article eleven of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled "Frederick County," sub-title "County Commissioners" to be designated as section ninety-five A, relating to the taxation of Saving Banks and Institutions located in Frederick County.

Section added. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That an additional section be and the same is hereby enacted and added to article eleven of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled "Frederick County" sub-title "County Commissioners" be designated as section ninety-five A, relating to the taxation of Saving Banks and Institutions located in Frederick City, and to read as follows :

Tax from savings banks. SEC. 95 A. It shall be the duty of the County Commissioners of Frederick County to pay over annually to the mayor and aldermen of Frederick, one-fourth of the franchise tax the said county commissioners shall receive under the provisions of section eighty-six of article eighty-one of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, from every savings bank, institution or corporation organized for receiving deposits of money and paying interest thereon located in the city of Frederick, having its principal office therein.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
