

CHAPTER 629.

AN ACT to refund to Thomas H. Harrison late collector of State taxes, for Calvert County a sum of money erroneously paid by him into the treasury.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer of this State in favor of Thomas H. Harrison, late collector of State taxes for Calvert County for the sum of seventeen dollars and forty-three cents, being the amount overpaid by him into treasury for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, the same having received the recommendation of the treasury officials. Refunding
taxes.

SEC. 2. *And he it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

CHAPTER 630.

AN ACT to add a new section to article 4 to the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore" under a new sub-title to be called sub-title "Oysters," and to be known as section 704 A, relating to the licensing of measurers of oysters in the city of Baltimore and their compensation.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the following new sub-title, be and the same is hereby added to article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore" to be called sub-title "Oysters" and to be known as section 704 A, all oysters in the shell sold in the city of Baltimore shall be measured by a licensed measurer, any person may obtain a license therefor from the clerk of the Court of Common Pleas by paying therefor the sum of ten dollars and taking an oath before said clerk for the faithful performance of his duty, said license shall hold good for one year, a measurer shall receive for his services one-half cent per bushel to be paid equally by the buyer and seller, any person violating the provisions of this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.
