

eighteen hundred and eighty-six and eighteen hundred and eighty-seven respectively and that a portion of said taxes remain unpaid ; therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That all taxes heretofore levied by the County Commissioners of Worcester County for the said years 1886 and 1887 and not yet collected by the said Edgar W. Mc-Master may be collected in accordance with existing law within two years from the passage of this act. Power to collect taxes

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

CHAPTER 647.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Charles County in their discretion to levy a certain sum of money to pay H. Clagett Page of said county for indexing the land records of said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Charles County in their discretion, are hereby authorized and empowered to levy upon the assessable basis of said county, a sum of money which in their discretion may seem just, to pay H. Clagett Page for indexing the land records of said county. Levy to pay for indexing.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.
