CHAPTER 660.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and twenty-nine of article eighteen of the Public Local Laws, title "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "County Commissioners" and to re-enact same with amendments, to be designated section one hundred and twenty-nine.

**Repealed.** SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section one hundred and twenty-nine of article eighteen of the Public Local Laws, title "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "County Commissioners" be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows :

**Clerk of County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County.** SEC. 29. The clerk of the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County shall receive annually, as a compensation for his services, such sum as the county commissioners may deem proper, not exceeding eight hundred dollars ; and said clerk is empowered to administer an oath or affirmation to any account to any person presenting a claim to the commissioners, against the county ; but he shall not administer such oath or affirmation in any other place than in his office, and he shall not be allowed to charge any fee for such oath or affirmation so administered.

**Effective.** SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 661.

AN ACT requiring the County Commissioners of Baltimore County to grade, kerb and macadamize the road or way now called Eastern avenue at Highandtown in the above named county.
