badges. County be and they are hereby authorized and directed to furnish the sheriff, deputy sheriff and constables of said county with official badges to be worn upon the person of said sheriff, deputy sheriff and constables of said county whenever in the discharge of their official duties so as to be displayed when necessary to show their official authority, and said official badges to cost a sum not exceeding three dollars each.

How to be
worn. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the sheriff, deputy sheriff and constables of said county be and they are hereby required to wear said official badges on their person in a position easily of display, at all times when in the discharge of their official duties, and upon the expiration of their respective term of office said badges shall be returned in good condition to said county commissioners of said county, and any failure upon the part of the officers cited to comply with the provisions of this act shall subject them to a fine not exceeding the sum of ten dollars.

Effective SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 666.

AN ACT to add an additional section to article twenty-three of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Corporation," to be designated as section thirty-nine A, (39 A).

section. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly, of Maryland*, That an additional section, designated thirty-nine A, be added to article twenty-three of the Code of Public General Laws title "Corporations," to follow section thirty-nine of said article and to read as follows :

When the aforesaid certificate of union shall have been executed, acknowledged and recorded as provided in section 39 of this article, all the property and assets belonging to said former separate corporations of whatsoever nature and description, and all the powers and rights and all the debts and liabilities of said former separate corporations of whatsoever nature and description, shall upon such recording as aforesaid, be devolved upon said new consolidated corporation, and every devise or bequest in
