SEC. 24. And be it enacted, That the commissioners shall expendit expend, or contract to expend, in any one year more three. not expend, or contract to expend, in any one year more money than the amount receivable from taxes and other sources for that year.

SEC. 25. And he it enacted. That the commissioners for the county, justices of the peace, sheriff, constables and all the county and State officers, hold and exercise their offices and jurisdiction in said town.

SEC. 26. And he it enacted, That the town commissioners shall have power to lay out, upon and establish new streets, lanes and alleys in said town, and fix the width and limits of the same, and shall proceed in same manner, and under the same regulations, restrictions and conditions as now govern the county commissioners in opening new public roads; they shall have power to establish building lines on all the streets in said town, or which shall hereafter be opened therein, and compel all persons hereafter erecting buildings in said town to conform thereto.

SEC. 27. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Reflective. from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 690.

AN ACT to repeal sections 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109, 110, 111, 112, 113, 115, 116 of article fourteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Howard County," sub-title "Roads," and to add an additional section thereto to follow 119, and to be known as 119 A, and to enact the following in lieu thereof, and submitting the same to the voters of the several election districts of Howard County: provided however that if the said voters of any of the several election districts shall not adopt the provisions of this act then the said sections 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109, 110, 111, 112, 113, 115 and 116 of article fourteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Howard County," subtitle "Roads," shall be and remain in full force and effect as to said election districts not adopting this act.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections one hundred and four, one hundred and five, one hundred and six, one hundred and seven, one
