To the several bequests, contained in the last will and testament of James Boyce, of five thousand dollars, to the Kelso Home for Orphans of the Methodist Episcopal Church; of five thousand dollars, to the Union Protestant Infirmary of the city of Baltimore, and of five thousand dollars to the Home for the Friendless. 10. To the bequests contained in the last will and testament of Sarah Jane Fitch, late of Baltimore City, Maryland, deceased, of fifty dollars to the trustees of the Catholic Cathedral Church of Baltimore; of fifty dollars to the Redemptionists of Baltimore City; of one hundred dollars to the Ammondale Monumental Institute of Prince George's County; of fifty dollars to James Gibbon's, Roman Catholic Archbishop of Baltimore, and his successors, and of thirty-five dollars to Reverend J.
